How to configure a Mac for a Keyspan USB-to-serial cable

1.	Install the latest driver from Keyspan:		
	http://www.keyspan.com/downloads/homepage	pn	usa19hs.spml

2.	Open	up	a	terminal	window.	Type:
----	------	----	---	----------	---------	-------

ls -lt /dev/tty* | head

This will list your ports:

The keyspan serial port is /dev/tty.USA19H3d1P1.1

3. Use the unix "cu or minicom" command to communicate with the NetRS (like hyperterminal):

cu -1/dev/tty.USA19H3d1P1.1 -s115200

or

minicom -s (then setup minicom to your serial port)
